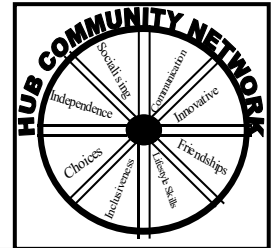

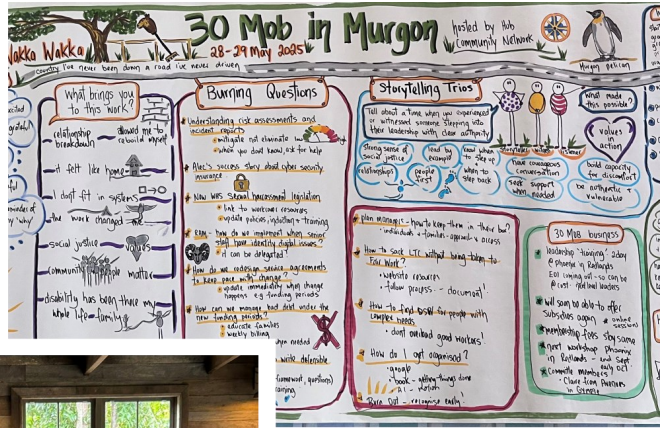

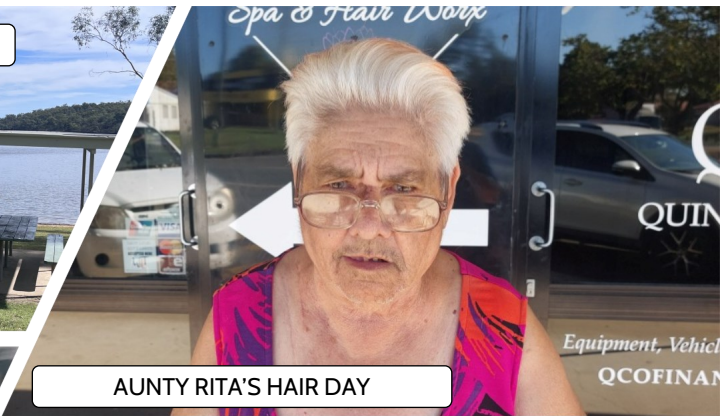

NDIA Quarterly Report Overview. (Q3 2024–25)

This report provides an overview of the performance and operations of the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) for the third quarter of 2024-25. It highlights progress, trends and areas of focus in the continued delivery of the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS).

- **NDIS Growth:** Over 717,000+ participants are now receiving support through the NDIS. This includes 27,000 new participants this quarter!
- **Compliance Action:** The NDIS Commission ramps up to protect the rights of people with disability! 55 banning orders issued against individuals, 1,108 refusals of registration, and 1,036 corrective action requests issued.
- **Plan Budget:** \$82,500 on average (up 5.3% annually). \$45 billion in payments have been made over the past year.
